TB has always been one of the few diseases which generally have patients flooding into the hospital daily. People come to the hospital for a general check-up and on further investigations find to be suffering from TB. Patients tend to relapse either due to discontinuation of the medication or due to the long duration of taking the medication. Patients tend to stop the medication once symptoms are relieved and hence end up coming to the OPD a few months later due to the reappearance of symptoms.
